Call to Order and Approval of Minutes

Co-President Sarah Hogan called the meeting to order via videoconferencing due to the Covid pandemic, at 8:05 a.m.

Treasurer's Report

Economic Vitality Committee – Ken Jones

Reminded board of the challenge faced by local business community due to Covid

Would like feedback from students on what businesses they would like to see added in the area Some businesses have opened without doing proper licensing, planning, and zoning.

The committee is thinking about promoting this info to landlords and realtors to share with perspective businesses
